BORROW A STREAM HEALTH ASSESSMENT KIT OR MARINE METRES SQUARED KIT

The stream kits contain everything needed to undertake a basic assessment of stream health.

The marine metres squared kits help your students to survey the plants and animals living on the rocky or sandy shore.

TAKE A TRIP

GW can subsidise student transport by up to \$500 per year for schools using the kits or working with Mountains to Sea Wellington, Sustainable Coastlines or Conservation Volunteers New Zealand. The grant is offered on a sliding scale based on school decile.

TAKE ACTION

GW can support your students to take action to improve biodiversity through the Kaitiaki project fund. Whether it's plants, predator traps, or other items, GWRC can fund up to a maximum of \$500 per year for costs associated with Kaitiaki projects for a limited number of schools.
